

The afternoon session opened with the reading of the message of Anastasios, Archbishop of Tirana and Albania, by Bylis Asti, a bishop of the Orthodox Church of Albania, which for the first time sent a representative to our meeting. Then Panteleimon Manoussakis spoke of the Spirit as the only source and support of the Christian testimony [READ THE PAPER], that of God through the incarnation of Jesus Christ. Ekaterini Tsalampouni, in her paper, has considered the sayings of Jesus on persecution, beginning from the passage in the Gospel of Matthew 5:11: "Blessed are you when they persecute you for my sake". Finally Georgij Zakharov has analyzed the theme of martyrdom and of the unity of the Church in St. Ambrose and the Latin fathers of the fourth century, starting from the expression "Omnes unum sumus in Christo".
