Who?

What?

Where?

By the monastic community of Bose (North Italy), a community composed by Christians of different traditions living together and engaging themselves in ecumenical dialog.



Language

The sharing will be in English, common prayers will mainly (but not exclusively) be in Italian, more informal exchanges will be in Italian, English and French.

To discover that:
there are young Christians like me belonging to different Churches which are not fully in communion;
differences can be a way to unity if they lead to a respectful curiosity;
Christ is one and cannot be divided, so it is an urgent and engaging task to take concrete steps towards the unity of his body..
